- ✓ Antizionism is a thing, an apple, a really-existing phenomenon.
- ✓ Antizionism has consolidated three core libels (colonizer, apartheid, genocide) across its history.
- ✓ The three genealogical sources of antizionism are Nazi-Islamist axis, Soviet propagnada, and Western settler-colonial theory, not pre-1948 Jewish anti-Zionism.
- ✓ Antizionism is distinct from classical antisemitism, inverting its central tropes (e.g. 'non-white infiltrator' to 'white colonizer').
- ✓ Antizionism must be treated on its own terms to combat it effectively.
